

# METHOD BOOK CORRELATION & TRANSFER GUIDE

The best entry points into the Supersonics Piano Method are at Level One, the Blast Off Bridge and Level Four. Entering the system at one of these three places will ensure that a student has the smoothest transition possible (you will not need to backtrack to cover any major concepts). Other entry points are possible but will require transfer plans tailored to the individual student's knowledge base. I have colour-coded the three entry points in the table below. Here's how to use the chart:

- If a student is currently working in a book in the yellow section (or has completed other Primer level books) simply move across to Supersonics Piano Method Level One.
- If a student is about to complete a book in the yellow section then progress on to the Blast Off Bridge book when they have completed their current book.
- If a student is currently working in a book in the green section then move across to the Blast Off Bridge book.
- If a student is about to complete one of the final books in the green section then progress on to Supersonics Piano Method Level Four when they have completed their current book.
- If a student is currently working on a book in the blue section then move across to Supersonics Piano Method Level Four.

For some students it may mean that their pieces are "easy" for a while but they will be catching up in other important areas (technique, contemporary harmony and a different note-reading approach). Note that it may be necessary for students transferring over to the Supersonics Piano Method at Level Four to complete Pop School Level One if they need to learn the basics of contemporary harmony.
